Deciduous-

trees that shed their leaves once a year, usually during the season of autumn, when their leaves are mature, or fully grown.



Evergreen-

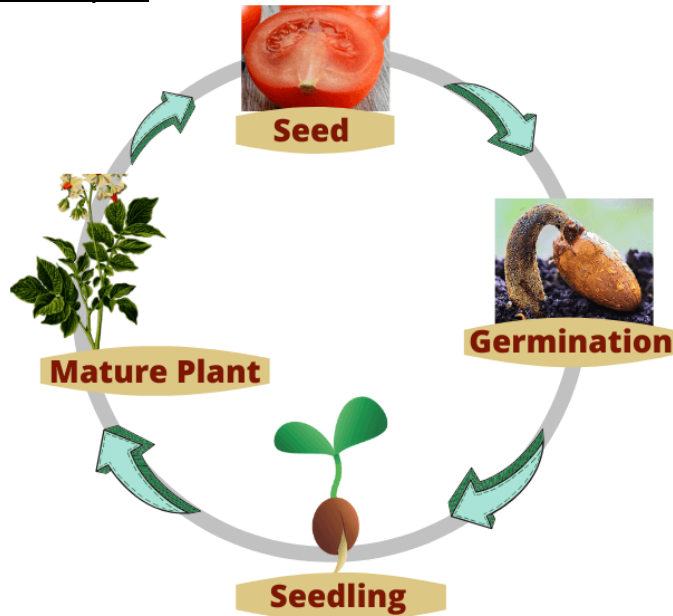
Plants/trees that never lose their leaves - they "stay green" all year long. Most coniferous plants are evergreen, but there are some exceptions.



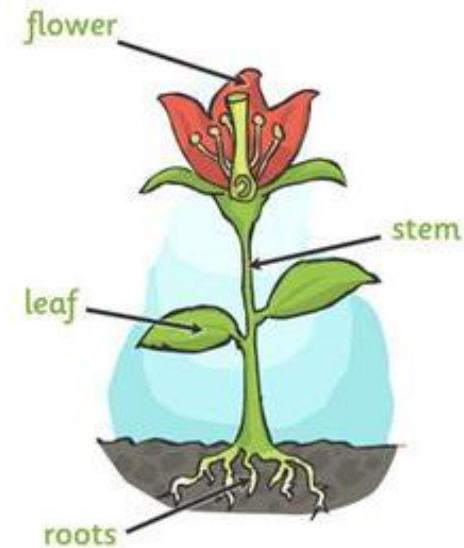
FACT
